Zinn has been creating original artwork in and around Ann Arbor for more than 20 years. In addition to his extensive portfolio of professional commissions, he is also known all over the world for the art he creates under his feet. His temporary street art, composed of chalk, charcoal, and found objects, are always improvised on location.




