- \$200 Committee's Choice

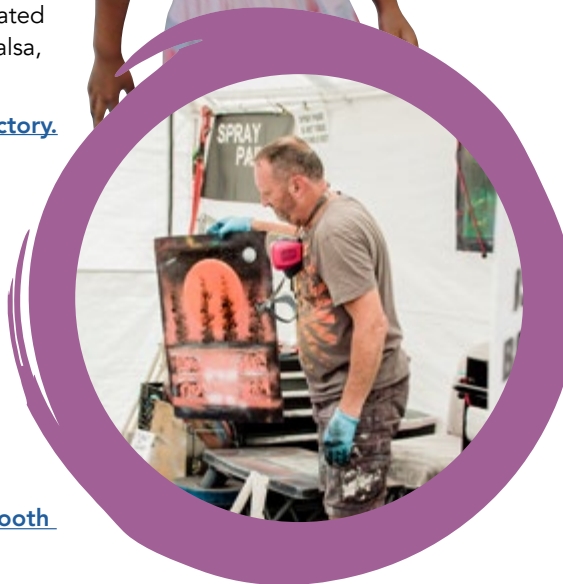

The Lakeshore Art Festival welcomes more than 20 authors who will showcase their original books in a variety of genres near Clay Ave and Fourth St.

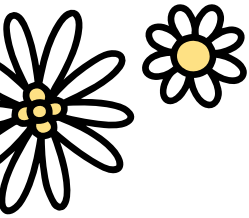

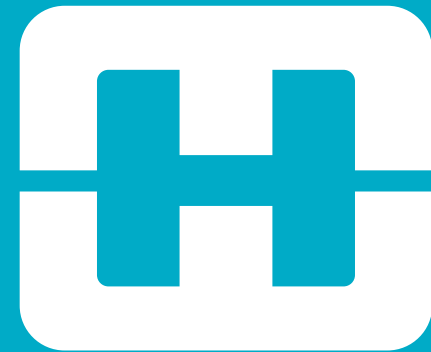

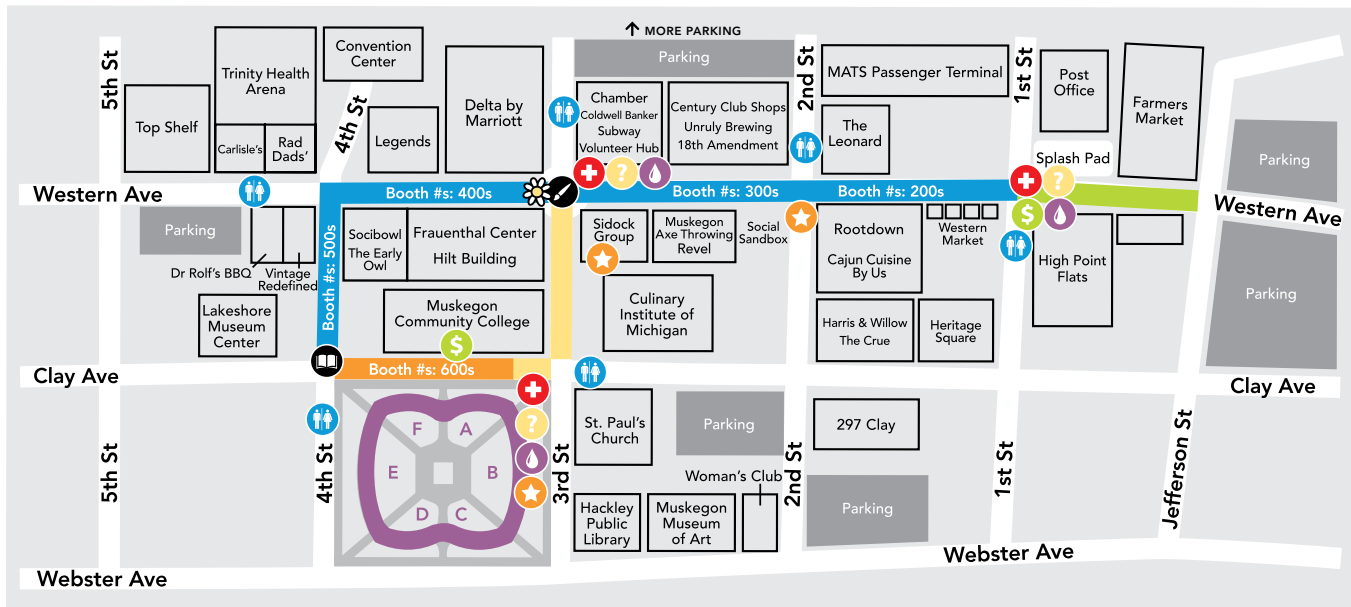
